As the Admiral Nurse you will:

**Lead on the delivery of work streams that improve the experience of care for people living with young onset dementia and their families, from pre-diagnosis to post-bereavement.**

You will initially be employed by Younger People With Dementia and based in Wokingham (a secondment from an NHS organisation will be considered), supporting people living with young onset dementia and their families across Surrey Heath, Farnham and NE Hants. You will receive unique, bespoke professional development and ongoing support from Dementia UK's Admiral Nurse Academy to maintain and strengthen your clinical expertise.
